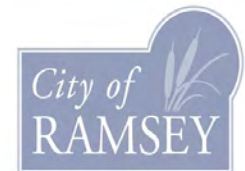

What is Ramsey Citizen's Academy?

The Ramsey Police Citizen's Academy is an intensive and interactive hands-on seven week course.



This academy is an opportunity to increase communication and ongoing information sharing with participants, and reduce misunderstandings regarding police operations. We encourage participants to share their ideas on how to control and prevent crime in the community. In return, we hope participants will use their experiences in the academy to educate others.

Who is Eligible to Attend?

Applicants must live or work in the City of Ramsey, be at least 18 years old, pass a criminal background check and be able to attend all seven weeks of the academy. In order to receive the full benefit of the program, it is crucial that you attend all classes.

Goals

Our goal is to develop positive police/community relationships and expose participants to information and experiences that demonstrate our police operations.
