

Electric Scooters

Electric scooters (that operate at a speed of 15 mph or less) now follow similar regulations as bicycles, meaning they can be operated on streets and highways without a driver's license and without the vehicle being registered, licensed, or insured.

Additionally, the following rules apply for motorized scooters whenever operated on a public street or highway.

- A person must be at least 12 years of age to operate a motorized scooter on public streets and highways.
- A helmet is required by anyone operating a motorized scooter under the age of 18.
- Motorized scooters may not be operated on sidewalks, except when necessary to go on or off adjacent property.
- An operator of a motorized scooter cannot carry anyone but the operator.
