RE: Project Update Letter #4 – **Sunwood Drive & Waco Street Reconstruction**

On Tuesday, September 20, the Contractor is proposed to pave the final lift of bituminous pavement. During placement of the first lift of pavement, the road closed to thru traffic signs were not being observed by the traveling public, which increases the safety risks as well as the quality of the product. To avoid this, Sunwood Drive and Waco Street will be closed on September 20<sup>th</sup> during the paving operations.

The closure will occur in phasing. Phase 1 will include closing Sunwood Drive between Trunk Highway 47 and Waco Street, including the side streets. Waco Street will be open to traffic while paving operations are occurring on Sunwood Drive. It's anticipated that Sunwood Drive paving will be complete around midday, at which time traffic control will be switched to Phase 2.

Phase 2 closes Waco Street between Sunwood Drive and 150<sup>th</sup> Avenue. Once final rolling is complete on Sunwood Drive, it will be opened to traffic from Xkimo Street to Trunk Highway 47. Waco Street will remain closed to traffic until paving and final rolling is complete. Be advised City work hours are from 7:00 am to 10 pm per City Code, it's not anticipated for paving operations to occur after dark, but this is a possibility.

During the full road closers, emergency vehicle access will be maintained if an emergency occurs. However, City Staff recommends residents with direct access to Waco Street park a car on the street outside of the road closure area if they believe use of their vehicle will be necessary during the road closure.
