### Charge

#### Appliances

Household Appliances .....\$20.00 ea  
Treadmills/Exercise Bike/Ellipticals.....\$20.00 ea

#### Tires

Passenger/Light Truck/ATV/UTV (*on or off rim*).....\$10.00 ea  
Semi/Tractor (*on or off rim*).....\$20.00 ea

#### Fluorescent Bulbs

4-ft & Smaller Tubes, Circular, U-Tubes, and CFLs.....\$.50 ea  
Over 4-ft. Tubes.....\$1.00 ea  
HID.....\$2.00 ea  
*Please have an accurate count of bulbs to expedite your time in line.*

#### Mattresses and Box Springs

Mattresses and Box Springs (*any condition*) .....\$35.00 ea

#### Electronics, Televisions & Computer Monitors

ALL TV's.....\$20.00 ea  
Printers, Desktop Copiers and Scanners .....\$5.00 ea  
Vacuums, Toaster Ovens and Air Fryers.....\$5.00 ea  
Laptops, CPUs (*towers*) and other Misc. Electronics.....FREE

#### Batteries

Alkaline, NiCad and Nickel Metal Hydride .....\$1.50 per lbs  
Lithium Ion.....\$5.00 per lbs  
Sealed Lead Acid.....FREE  
*Any Lithium Ion batteries must be kept separate from other batteries.  
This is for safety purposes and to expedite time in line.*

#### Scrap Metal (ACE Solid Waste)

All non-metal parts and fluids **must be removed**.....FREE

#### Used Oil (East Side Oil Companies)

Used Oil, Oil Filters and Antifreeze  
(*bring empty containers home to dispose*).....FREE

#### Standard Household Materials (ACE Solid Waste)

Food & Beverage Glass Containers .....FREE  
Aluminum, Steel and Tin Cans.....FREE  
Newspaper, Magazines and Cardboard .....FREE  
Plastic Bottles, Tubs and Lids (< 1 gallon size) .....FREE  
Bikes.....FREE

### FREE Document Destruction/Paper Shredding

All types of paper accepted, no need to remove staples, paper clips or rubber bands! No 3-ring binders.  
**Limit of 3 boxes (12" x 12" x 24") per vehicle.**

### Please Note:

- Certain road accesses may be temporarily closed during the event for traffic control purposes. Please see map on page 13 for directions to site.
- At certain times during the recycling event, you may experience a short waiting time due to heavy traffic. Please be patient and we will serve you as quickly as possible.
- The following is the order in which materials will be unloaded at the event, please load your vehicle accordingly:
  - Batteries
  - Used oil, oil filters and antifreeze
  - Bikes
  - Paper shredding
  - Scrap metal and curbside recyclables
  - Tires
  - Electronics
  - Fluorescent bulbs
  - Appliances
  - Mattresses and box springs

### Materials NOT Accepted:

- Garbage of any kind
- Yard and tree waste
- Window/door glass panes
- Plastic containers > 1 gallon
- Construction debris, paint or other household hazardous waste materials identified by staff.
- Furniture (*except mattresses/box springs*)

**All fees payable to TRC.  
Fees will be collected at event entrance.  
Payment by cash, check or credit card.**
