- June 13:** Japan - Create a Japanese Koi fish with ink and liquid watercolor on watercolor paper.
- July 11 :** Australia - Create a Great Barrier Reef Blue Ringed Octopus from polymer clay.
- July 25:** Mexico - Be inspired by Frida Kahlo's love of animals to create a parrot on a canvas panel.
- August 1:** Spain - Have fun creating a Pablo Picasso type animal with watercolor pencils and markers.
- August 15:** India - Join artist Jamini Roy and journey into Indian culture to create a Jamini Roy bird and cat using watercolor pencils and pens.
- August 16:** Create the Ancient Sphinx, watercolor pencils on watercolor paper project.
