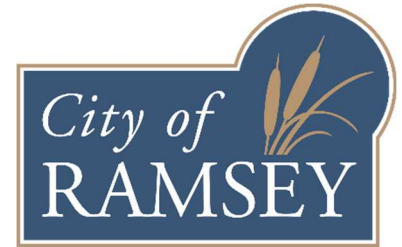


NEW RESIDENT RECYCLING INFORMATION

Welcome to the City of Ramsey!

The City of Ramsey has a simple sort recycling system which eliminates the need for any separating of recyclable materials! Details on the curbside recycling program are on the backside of this page. Also included in this mailing are some recycling stickers for your calendar that can be used to remind you of your scheduled recycling day.

If you are interested in a small, 6 gallon recycling bin that can fit inside a kitchen cabinet and is ideal to collect office paper, junk mail, etc., you can pick one up at the Ramsey Municipal Center during regular business hours (8:00-4:30pm).

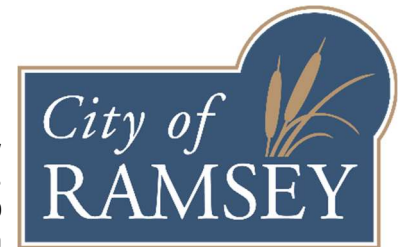
The City of Ramsey also has an Organics Recycling Drop-Off program for those that are interested in helping further reduce the amount of material going to the landfill. For more information on this new program, please visit www.cityoframsey.com/organics. You can register for the program online and then pick up an organics starter kit from the Planning Division at the Ramsey Municipal Center during our normal business hours.



Finally, the City coordinates two (2) Recycling Day events each year, one in the spring and one in the fall. Recycling Day events are typically held on a Saturday from 8:00 am to 12:00 pm. These events provide residents an opportunity to properly dispose of materials not generally accepted through the curbside program, such as electronics, appliances, fluorescent bulbs, scrap metal, tires, used oil, oil filters and antifreeze, mattresses and box springs, and document destruction (usually limited to 3 banker boxes or less). Municipalities are required by state law to ensure that residents have access to an opportunity to recycle. The City of Ramsey accomplishes this through a contract with ACE Solid Waste for the curbside collection of recyclables. Each household is charged \$3.98 per month for recycling.

A recycling cart is available by contacting ACE Solid Waste at 763-427-3110 or by email at service@acesolidwaste.com. The cart will be delivered to your driveway. Recycling carts must be placed at the street by 6:30 am on the scheduled day of collection. Collection occurs on alternating Mondays for each half of the City. The City is currently divided into east and west collection zones along Nowthen Blvd and Sunfish Lake Blvd (see map below).

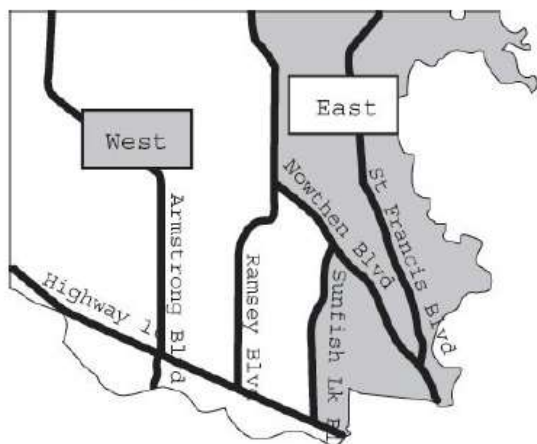

Accepted Materials & Preparation

All acceptable materials can be placed directly into the recycling cart. Acceptable materials do not need to be separated, but please break down cardboard boxes, cut into 3 foot by 3 foot sections and bundle them with string or twin before placing in the cart. Please DO NOT include any plastic bags in the recycling cart. The following materials are acceptable:

- Newspaper, magazines, catalogs, & phone books
- Direct mail advertising and envelopes of all types
- File folders, notebooks, and clean paper bags
- Colored paper, fax, and telex sheets, and office/computer paper
- Shredded paper (place in paper bag and staple or tape bag shut)
- Boxboard (4 C's); cereal, cake, chips, and corrugated cardboard (remove cellophane and foil liners)
- Metal food can and aluminum beverage cans (rinse)
- Glass jars and bottles (remove lids and caps; rinse)
- Plastic bottles, containers, tubs and lids up to 1-gallon size (rinse, leave caps on)
- Paper cartons including milk, juice, soup and broth cartons (rinse)
